**1. Glenstone Park Update-**

Brett Barber, Park & Recreation Director, presented a drawing of the design option under consideration for Glenstone Park. Barber explained that this design was geared to the age 2- 12 year olds. Board discussion was held on the various product types they could use for the playground materials as well as the option of developing the entire park at one time rather than in phases as originally planned.

**3. Sports Club Update-**

Scott also wanted to relay some concerns the soccer club had about some of the parks. Scott asked about changing the automatic locking of the restrooms at the concession stand. He said the current schedule for the locking was not working out with their clubs field usage. Scott believed that the storm may have knocked the timer off schedule and probably just needed to be reset. Scott also noted that the soccer bleachers had not been anchored down and had

blown over during the storm that pasted thru Grimes last week. Scott said that there had been damage to the irrigation system during that storm as well.

**4. Park & Rec Director Comments- Summer Rec/Fall Programming-**

Barber stated that Ryan Anderson would be attending the next park and rec meeting and would present the results from the summer tournaments. Barber indicated the tournaments seemed to go pretty well and that they would need to have discussion on next year's tournament schedule. Barber also stated that program registrations would begin October 1<sup>st</sup>. Barber also reported that the lights along Main Street should be up by the end of the week.
