Special Census: Very soon Grimes will conduct a Special Census to get an updated population count. This new count will help us qualify for state revenues we need to provide essential services like street repair, education for our children, services for our seniors, and other important activities we depend on every day.

Census Jobs - Earn Extra Money Helping Our Community: Most positions involve locating households, updating addresses, and conducting interviews with respondents. A few involve supervisory or clerical duties. Jobs last anywhere from 2 to 8 weeks. Enumerators work flexible hours, primarily evenings and weekends when respondents are home.
