



CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

The City of Grimes is pleased to announce that the Chevalia Valley Trail and Pedestrian Bridge project is scheduled to begin this September.

The first construction that will occur is the installation of the pedestrian bridge over the creek that is between Bridge Creek Subdivision and Chevalia Valley Subdivision. This construction work is being completed by Herberger Construction from Indianola, Iowa. Herberger plans on starting the second week of September and will complete channel grading, installing bridge abutments and installing channel rip rap. The pedestrian bridge has to be fabricated and could be delivered and installed sometime near the end of October or the beginning of November.

The trail project begins at N. James Street and follows the tributary of Little Beaver Creek to existing trail in Bridge Creek Subdivision. Part of this trail was installed with the Chevalia Trace subdivision that occurred this summer.

The section of trail that begins in the rear yard of 2300 NE Chevalia Court and ends at the pedestrian bridge is to be installed by a contractor working for the developer of Chevalia Valley Subdivision, JBTT. There is a possibility this work will be completed yet this construction season but the work will not start until the pedestrian bridge is installed. This section of trail will be lathed along the centerline so that residents whose back yards abut the trail can better visualize the construction.

The other section of the trail that starts at the south side of Chevalia Trace subdivision and connects to North James Street is to be installed by a contractor working for Peoples Trust and Savings Bank. This work should be completed this construction season.
