

CHEVALIA PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE AND TRAIL

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Herberger Construction is mobilizing equipment this week and next week will begin channel grading, installing bridge abutments and installing channel rip rap. The pedestrian bridge is being fabricated and could be delivered and installed sometime near the middle of November. Herberger Construction will access the construction site from Bridge Creek subdivision.


The trail project begins at N. James Street and follows the tributary of Little Beaver Creek to existing trail in Bridge Creek Subdivision. Part of this trail was installed with the Chevalia Trace subdivision that occurred this summer.

The section of trail that begins in the rear yard of 2300 NE Chevalia Court and ends at the pedestrian bridge is to be installed by CTI who is working for the developer of Chevalia Valley Subdivision, JBTT. CTI has hired a grading subcontractor who is scheduled to begin excavation and rip rap placement on Tuesday October 9, 2012. The contractors working on this portion of the trail plan to access the site from Chevalia Trace Subdivision.

The other section of the trail that starts at the south side of Chevalia Trace subdivision and connects to North James Street is to be installed by a contractor working for Peoples Trust and Savings Bank. This work should be completed this construction season.
