Notice of Street Resurfacing

The City hired contractor, Grimes Asphalt and Paving Corp., will be resurfacing roads in your neighborhood.

- To:** Grimes Residents North of NW 7th St.
- Purpose:** Resurface N. James St. with Hot Mix Asphalt
- Locations:** N. James St. from NW 7th St. to NW 27th St.
- Estimated Duration:** 3 Days (weather permitting)

Grimes Asphalt and Paving will be patching and milling on Monday, October 29th. One lane will remain open during this time, but motorists should be aware of construction equipment on the roadway. There may be short durations when equipment will block your driveway. Please allow some extra time in your schedule to accommodate any minor delays you may encounter.

Paving of the road will tentatively begin on Tuesday, October 30th, and finish on Wednesday, October 31st. During this time, the road will be **CLOSED TO THRU TRAFFIC**. Said closure will be in force from 8:30 AM until 3:00 PM.

It is probable that the normal route to and from your property will be blocked. If your route is blocked, attempt to use a connecting street off N. James to access your property. Note that it may be necessary to drive the 5-mile loop as shown on the enclosed maps to access your property. Please refer to the enclosures to help you navigate to and from your property. The street needs to be dry for these operations so please turn off your irrigation if your system is draining into the street.

If this work is scheduled on the day of your normal garbage pickup, place your containers at the end of your driveway and the contractor will coordinate with the City's refuse hauler so that your service is not interrupted.

Please reduce your speed through work zones to ensure your safety as well as the Public Work's and contractor's personnel. We appreciate your patience and cooperation during the resurfacing.
