4 min., 45 second call with Scott Clyce & Joe McAreavey, returned Scott's voice mail from 12:34
Scott called to say the City had been visited by DNR/Iowa Waters Program who were concerned by brown water in the northern part of town.

Joe said he went and investigated. The water was clean/clear west of the RR trestle box culvert, he went in at Blake Putneys' property, and didn't see dirty water until opposite the sports complex.
It appeared to Joe that all of the controls (silt fence) were in-place and functioning and that it may have been an isolated discharge from a localized point. Appears the water cleared up after an hour.
Joe noticed it appeared the contractor was placing sand or clay (loose material) on top of surrounding material.

Told him I would make a site visit and see if there is anything that needs to be done.
I asked if there needs to be follow-up with the DNR, he didn't think so.

I called Lyle to find out his timeline for completing the remediation efforts.

Caught him in his planter. He said he isn't going to do anything until all the soybeans are planted. I asked him when he thought the work would be completed. He told me to predict the weather. Couldn't get a timeline from him as to what if the weather stayed nice scenario. He went on to complain about spending all morning making repairs to the planter and how it is supposed to rain again tonight.

He is having problems disposing of the contaminated soil he has in the dump truck sitting in the shed. Can't haul new soil for the shoulders until he disposes of the contaminated material. The disposal site in the Grimes area won't take the soil and referred him to Metro Waste Authority. MWA won't take the soil until he fills out toxicity report for Treflan and Lyle isn't certain where to get that information. Thinks he will have to spread the product on his own land. He isn't renting the Seibert property where the main part of the spill occurred.

Left it that I will call him back to check on progress.

He invited me to ride with him in his tractor to see the GPS system for planting. Told him I would like that
