

# Dispose of Old Tires, Appliances, and Yard Waste at Community Drop-Off Event

## TIRES:

If you are spinning your wheels trying to get rid of an old tire or two, we have some good news. Residents can dispose of old car and truck tires on **Saturday May 7<sup>th</sup> & Sunday May 8<sup>th</sup> 7:30am to 4:00pm at the new city shop at 1700 SE Destination DR.** Each household can drop off a maximum of five tires free of charge. Rims must be removed.

This drop-off does NOT ACCEPT:

- Tires generated by businesses
- Farm or tractor tires
- Solid tires (lawnmower, forklift or golf cart tires)
- Bicycle tires

Metro Waste Authority has year-round drop-off locations where residents can recycle tires for a fee. Tires can also be recycled with Liberty Tire in Des Moines.

White goods such as refrigerators, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, water heaters, freezers, washers and dryers may be disposed of, free of charge on **Saturday May 7<sup>th</sup> & Sunday May 8<sup>th</sup> 7:30am to 4:00pm at the new city shop at 1700 SE Destination DR.**



## Yard Waste:

Yard waste may be may be dropped off free of charge on **Saturday May 7<sup>th</sup> & Sunday May 8<sup>th</sup> 7:30am to 4:00pm at the new city shop 1700 SE Destination DR.** No special bags or stickers are required. Grimes residents only.
